Subject : **Three Suspects Arrested In Redondo Beach for Burglary**

The Redondo Beach Police Department arrested three people today and charged them with burglary. Redondo Officers received a call this morning, of three men trying to break into a house, in the 1800 block of Stanford Ave. The suspect's broke open a front window to enter the residence. When the first officers arrived, the suspects fled out the back window. A containment was set up around a five block area, in north Redondo Beach. Within 15 minutes, the first suspect was arrested. He was located hiding in a dumpster behind the business, located in the 1200 block of Artesia. A search of the area was conducted for the two remaining suspects. Officers from the cities of Redondo Beach, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, Torrance and the LASO Helicopter conducted the search. Police K-9's from Redondo Beach and Torrance also assisted in the search.

At about 9:30 AM, the second suspect was seen by the helicopter. The suspect was hiding under a deck, in the backyard of a residence in the 1800 block of Harper Ave. The suspect was then arrested by officers. The third suspect was finally arrested at 12:45 PM, when he was seen running from his hiding place, in the 1800 block of Harper. The suspect was chased by officers and arrested in the 1800 block of Goodman.

The suspects included two adults and one juvenile. The two adults were Derrell Seymore, 22 years-old, from Compton, and Lamont Hall 18 years-old from Los Angeles.
