

## **PART I CRIME DEFINITIONS**

<b>HOMICIDE</b>	Murder and nonnegligent manslaughter are counted. Willful killing of one human being by another; attempts are counted as aggravated assault.
<b>RAPE</b>	Forcible rape is the carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will; attempts are included.
<b>ROBBERY</b>	Taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.
<b>AGGRAVATED ASSAULT</b>	Unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury; attempts are included. <b>Aggravated</b> assaults are usually accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.
<b>BURGLARY</b>	Unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft; attempts are included.
<b>LARCENY-THEFT</b>	Unlawful taking...away of property from the possession of constructive possession of another; attempts are included.
<b>STOLEN VEHICLE</b>	Unlawful theft of a motor vehicle; attempts are included.
<b>ARSON</b>	Setting fire unlawfully.
