



Redondo Beach Recreation and Community Services Mobil Skate Park Rules

The following rules must be followed by all users and enforced by staff!

- Skateboarding and in-line skating are hazardous activities. Skate at your risk and within your own ability.
- Skateboards and in-line skates only. No bicycles or motorized vehicles.
- All users must have a permission slip/liability waiver on file. All users under age 18 must have parental/guardian permission prior to entering park.
- Helmets, knee pads, and elbow pads are required.
- Failure to use safety equipment will subject persons to be denied access to the skate park.
- Skating on public sidewalks, curbs and park benches is prohibited.
- No graffiti, tagging or glass beverage containers.
- Participants may not use or consume food, beverages, alcohol, tobacco products or illegal drugs.
- Participants may not be under the influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
- No spectators allowed in the skate area.
- No non-city equipment, obstacles or apparatus may be brought onto skate area.
- Inappropriate behavior or disregard for safety or the above stated rules will result in denied access to the skate park.
- The City of Redondo Beach has the sole and exclusive discretion to close the skate park facility due to inclement weather, wet pavement, or any other unsafe condition at any time.
