Subject : Three Arrested for Residential Burglary

The Redondo Beach Police Dept. arrested three suspects on Wednesday August 27, 2008, and charged them with residential burglary. Daryl Jackson, 19 years-old from Inglewood, Charles Johnson Jr., 19 years-old from Hawthorne, and Markeisha Reed, 20 years-old from Los Angeles.

The three suspects were arrested in connection with a residential burglary that occurred on Thursday, August 21st, at 3:00 PM, in the 1900 Block of Speyer Ln. In that burglary, the suspects broke into the home, but were later confronted by the homeowner when she returned home. The two suspects pushed the victim down and ran from the house, taking valuables from the house with them. The suspects were last seen getting into a vehicle and fleeing the area. Police believe that the “get away vehicle” was driven by Markeisha Reed. Just prior to this burglary both suspects tried to break into another house in the same block of Speyer Ln. Officers were unable to locate the suspects immediately after the crimes.

Early this week fingerprints, found at both locations, linked Daryl Jackson and Charles Johnson to the burglaries. On Wednesday of this week Detectives from the RBPD Special Investigations Unit located suspects Jackson and Reed in the City of Inglewood and arrested both of them. Later on Wednesday, suspect Johnson was located at his home in Hawthorne and he too was arrested.
