Joseph Leonardi has announced that the Redondo Beach Police Department will host a Community Safety Fair and Police Department Open House on Sunday, October 5th, 2008, at the Civic Center and Police Facility. Activities will begin at 10:00 a.m. and conclude at 3:00 p.m. The event will feature tours of the Police Station, live demonstrations by the K-9, Motorcycle and S.W.A.T. Units, static displays of Police equipment and fire apparatus, safety and crime prevention exhibits, free gun locks, free child I.D. kits, entertainment and food free of charge to the public.

This will be the thirteenth annual event of its type in Redondo Beach. This event has hosted thousands of visitors over the past twelve years.

As part of the Community Oriented Policing philosophy, the Police Department's doors will be open to the public. Everybody is invited to tour the Police facility and enjoy the activities at the Safety Fair. There will be numerous photo opportunities.

The Fire Department and components of the Police Department such as K-9, CSI, and S.W.A.T. will present displays and exhibits. The Safety Fair is the "kick-off" event for Fire Prevention Week and designating October as Crime Prevention Month.
