**Subject : Redondo Beach Police investigating collision involving a Hermosa Beach motorcycle officer.**

The Redondo Beach Police Department is investigating a collision that occurred in the 1100 Block of Artesia Ave. on Tuesday, June 8, 2010 that involved a Hermosa Beach Police motorcycle officer. The collision occurred at around 6:02 p.m. in the eastbound lanes when the officer's motorcycle came into contact with the rear of a BMW convertible that the officer was attempting to pull over for a traffic violation.

After the collision, the officer, Anthony Parente, was ejected from his police motorcycle landing in the back seat of the vehicle. Parente suffered moderate injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Parente was released from the hospital on Wednesday, the extent of his injuries is not known at this time.

Redondo Beach Police responded traffic investigators and detectives to the scene of the collision so that every possible angle can be investigated.
