

DATE/TIME: 11-01, 11-03, 11-04, 11-10, 11-11-10
Approx. 7:30AM, 2:00PM– 5:00 PM

LOCATION: Multiple S. Redondo Beach areas:
N. Paulina Ave. and Beryl Street, alley rear of 1200
block Amethyst Street, and 500 block Ave. G

SUSPECT: Male Hispanic, 30-40 years, 5'9/ large build "fat belly and double chin," mustache, dark complexion, unshaven, thick straight dark brown/ black hair "grown out buzz style," two RED BUMPS ON EITHER SIDE OF FACE, face "gets bigger at bottom," fidgeting and shaking a lot when talking to victim.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: older model silver/ gray
4 door sedan

DETAILS: During the first two weeks of November the suspect above made several attempts to contact two minors.

Beginning on November 1, 2010 the suspect followed a 14 year old female in his vehicle and attempted to speak to her on three different days as she walked home from school. On November 4, 2010 the suspect exited his vehicle and exposed himself to the minor. In each instance the suspect asked the minor questions and tried to engage her in conversation as he sat in his vehicle a close distance away.

In the second case the suspect was seen driving in an area where children were playing on November 10, 2010. On November 11, 2010 the suspect returned to the area and stopped next to an 11 year old female and he attempted to speak to her. The minor ran off as the suspect appeared to exit his vehicle. In both cases the suspect was driving the same vehicle.

The Redondo Beach Police Department would like to make the public aware of these two cases and they would like to request the public's help in identifying this suspect.
