Subject: New RV Ordinance Rolled Out

The City Of Redondo Beach will be rolling out a new ordinance regulating the parking of certain Recreational Vehicles and other large vehicles on city streets June 1, 2011. After numerous public meetings, in which citizens were able to voice their concerns, the City of Redondo Beach approved a new ordinance. The new ordinance which has been three years in the making will be enforced starting next month.

The new law balances the interests of those who want to limit overnight parking for RV owners and those RV owners that want to park their RV on the street. In essence the new ordinance restricts the overnight parking of RV's between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Redondo Beach residents and landowners must register their oversized vehicles with the City to park during the restricted hours that now require a permit. Permits can then be obtained allowing limited overnight parking, see attached flyer for more details.
