Subject: Four Men stabbed In Redondo Beach

Four Redondo Beach men were stabbed early this morning while they were leaving a Redondo Beach bar. The four men were leaving the Pitcher House Bar at 1:40 am, located in the 400 Block of North Pacific Coast Hwy, when they were attacked by two men. The two suspects punched and stabbed all four of the victims. One victim was stabbed and then knocked unconscious. The other victims also sustained numerous stab wounds. Three of the victims were transported to Harbor General Hospital the other was driven to the hospital by friends. The status of the victims is unclear at the time of this release.

Officers arrived within two minutes and were able to quickly arrest the two men as they tried to flee the area. The men are identified as Martin Reynosa, 24 years-old from Wilmington. The other suspect is Timothy Fitzpatrick, 23 years-old from Harbor Gateway. Both suspects were booked for attempted murder, four counts each, and both have a bail of \$2,000,000. The investigations is in the early stages, but detectives believe the fight may have initiated from inside the bar prior to the attack.
