### **UPDATE – Vehicle Located –**

The black Ford Mustang that Redondo Beach Police have been searching for in connection to this double homicide has been located in Mission Viejo. Orange County Sheriff's received a call this morning from a citizen who spotted the vehicle which was parked, and unoccupied near Interstate 5. Redondo Beach Detectives are taking possession of the vehicle as part of the Investigation.

The Redondo Beach Police Department would like to thank the public for all of the tips and information that have come in over the past day which has greatly assisted the investigation of this case.

Late in the evening of Tuesday, February 28, 2012 the Redondo Beach Police Department developed information that the suspect being sought in connection with this double homicide (Jonathan Chacon) may have fled into Mexico. Detectives worked through the night in conjunction with Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), Customs and Border Protection (CBP), and Mexican authorities to locate Chacon. Chacon was located at a Hotel in Rosarito Beach, Baja California early this morning (Thursday, February 29, 2012) and detained by Mexican authorities. Chacon has been transferred back to the United States and is currently in the custody of the Redondo Beach Police Department.

On February 28, 2012 at approximately 10:02 AM, the Redondo Beach Police Department received an emergency call to the dispatch center from a female who discovered two deceased females at 1903 Rockefeller Lane. Officers responded to the location and discovered two deceased females. Redondo Beach Police Department suspects foul play and is investigating this incident as a double homicide.
