On April 12, 2012 at approximately 12:41 p.m., a 68 year old Los Angeles resident was involved in a bicycle traffic collision in the 100 block of South Catalina.

Redondo Beach Fire Department responded originally to this incident as a one person medical assistance incident involving only the 68 year old bicyclist. The Redondo Beach Fire Department treated the 68 year old bicyclist and the bicyclist was transported to a local area hospital for serious injuries. It was determined that the incident was a traffic collision. Due to the nature of the injuries the Redondo Beach Police Department took over the incident as a collision investigation.
