**Subject : Redondo Beach Police conduct a series of Minor Decoy/Shoulder Tap Operations that result in the issuance of four citations.**

Redondo Beach Police conducted a series of Minor Decoy operations in the City of Redondo Beach on Friday, May 25, 2012 and Friday, June 15, 2012. The operations were part of a series of monthly operations being conducted in accordance with a Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control grant that was awarded to the City of Redondo Beach. One on-sale and one off-sale establishment were cited for selling alcohol to a minor. The purpose of the grant is to reduce underage drinking through enforcement and educational programs. This project is part of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control's Minor Decoy/Shoulder Tap Grant Project, funded by the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

These operations were two of several large scale operations that have been conducted over the course of the past several months commencing March 30, 2012 and culminated on June 15, 2012. A total of 13 different establishments were visited during the operations. Multiple minor decoys attempted to purchase alcohol from a total of two different on-sale establishments and eleven different off sale establishments in Redondo Beach. One of the on-sale locations and one of the off-sale locations completed the sale. Minor decoys also solicited twenty-three adults at seven different establishments to purchase alcohol. Two adults took money from the minor, purchased alcohol and provided the alcohol to the minor. Redondo Beach Police cited a total of four adults related to the violations.
