Subject: Traffic Collision on November 1, 2012 – Pacific Coast Highway and Pearl Street

On November 2, 2012 at about 8:00 p.m. a pedestrian was struck by a motor vehicle on Pacific Coast Highway, south of Pearl Street in Redondo Beach.

The pedestrian was walking on Pacific Coast Highway outside a crosswalk and was in the left lane (number #1 lane) for northbound traffic on Pacific Coast Highway when he was hit by the motor vehicle. A witness reported to police that the pedestrian appeared to be under the influence and was staggering in the roadway.

Preliminary information to police was that the pedestrian had died. However, while being transported to a local hospital the pedestrian had to be resuscitated, and was admitted to the hospital in critical condition. The pedestrian is still in the hospital, listed in critical condition.

It does not appear that the driver of the vehicle was under the influence of drugs or alcohol, and the driver was not injured.
