



City of Redondo Beach Notice to Contractors Inviting Bids

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for performing the following described work will be received at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Redondo Beach, 415 Diamond Street, Door C, Redondo Beach, California, until 10:00 A.M. on April 25, 2013. Thereafter said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Clerk's office of said City.

Sanitary Sewer Facilities Rehabilitation Project – Phase 10, Job No. 50150

The project work shall include the following tasks:

The project work shall include the removal and reconstruction of sewer mains and manholes citywide, per the project's plans and specifications, including all labor, tools, equipment, materials, traffic and safety control, potholing all existing utilities along the proposed alignment, shoring, sewer lateral connections, backfilling, compaction, testing, paving, protecting existing utility/facility in place, maintaining and temporary handling sewer flows, excavation, dewatering, removal and dispose interfering abandoned materials, subgrade preparation, laying of pipes at grade, temporary and permanent asphalt concrete street paving with bedding, easement notifications, all hand surgical chipping, aggregate base, and backfill, constructing to the required grades/depths, services for furnishing, testing, pipe cleaning and root removal, bypasses, Cured-in-Place Liner, Vitrified Clay Pipe extra strength pipe, CCTV inspection, and all appurtenant improvements as required in order to provide an operational sewer system complete-in-place.

Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Work:

1. Install 9,504 linear feet of Cured-in-Place Sewer Pipe Liner
2. Replace 1,030 linear feet of 8" Vitrified Clay Pipe with 10" Vitrified Clay Pipe
3. Replace 300 linear feet of 8" cast iron pipe with 8" Vitrified Clay Pipe
4. Spot Repairs on twenty eight (28) locations for an estimated length of 562 linear feet

Manhole Work:

All manhole covers and frames to be provided by City.

1. Replace twenty (20) vented manhole cover and frames
2. Demolish and rebuild two (2) manholes
3. Install one (1) new manhole
4. Uncover and repair thirteen (13) buried manholes

The estimated cost of the above described work is \$1,600,000. Bidders shall have an active **Class "A"** or **"C 42"** license from the Contractor's State License Board at the time of submitting bid.

Bidders and subcontractors are not required to pay the General Prevailing Wage Rates on this project.

Ten percent of the payments due to the successful Contractor shall be withheld by the City as retention for performance security, but the Contractor may substitute securities for said retention pursuant to Section 7.04 of the General Conditions.

If the Project includes the construction of a pipeline, sewer, sewage disposal system, boring and jacking pits, or similar trenches or open excavations, which are five feet or deeper, the bid shall contain, as part of the lump sum bid package, adequate sheeting, shoring, and bracing, or equivalent method, for the protection of life or limb, which shall conform to all applicable safety laws, rules, regulations and orders.

If the Bidder is awarded the contract, the contract shall be terminated and the bid bond forfeited if the Bidder fails to provide the applicable insurance certificates and bonds within the time set forth in Section 21 of the Instructions to Bidders.

Proposals (bids) to perform the work shall be made on the forms provided by the City Engineer and shall be submitted complete, including bid bond and list of subcontractors, in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and other requirements of the bid document. In order to qualify to bid this project, bidders must obtain and properly execute a hardcopy of the contract documents. Contract documents may be obtained from the City Public Works Department, Engineering Services Division, 415 Diamond Street, Door E, Redondo Beach, CA 90277, for a non-refundable fee of \$25 per set. Contract documents may be obtained by mail by paying an additional charge of \$10. Contract documents may also be obtained by FEDEX by providing recipient account information and paying an additional charge of \$5.
