Candidates interested in becoming an on-call volunteer victim advocate must:

- Possess own car, valid California driver's license and auto insurance.
- Be able to pass a background check.
- Work well as part of a team.
- Commit to comply with confidentiality requirements and policies governing police operations.
- Have the capacity to be on-call a minimum of four-twelve hour shifts a month including some evenings and weekends.
- Be able to climb up and down 20 or more stairs with no assistance.
- Live within 10 minutes of Redondo Beach.
- Participate in Program training/meetings, prevention and community program/activities.
