On August 15, 2013 at about 11:15 p.m., Redondo Beach Police Officers responded to the 500 block of Susana on a report of a female victim screaming. The victim was seen being dragged into a residence by a male suspect. Arriving officers located an elderly female victim outside of the residence who appeared to be the victim of an assault.

Officers saw the male suspect inside the residence near the front door. Believing that the suspect had committed an assault on the elderly female, officers gave the suspect verbal commands to attempt to take him into custody. The suspect was uncooperative with officers and refused to comply with their directives. Officers forced the front door open. The suspect armed himself with a knife, and an officer involved shooting occurred.

The suspect, Mitchell Allison, a forty-three year old resident of Redondo Beach, was injured in the shooting. Allison was transported by paramedics to Harbor General Hospital where he later died.

The Redondo Beach Police Department, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office is investigating this incident.

Further information about this incident may be released as the investigation progresses.
