On Sunday, July 6, 2014, at approximately 5:01 p.m. a citizen who had inadvertently purchased a stolen bicycle contacted a patrol officer in the lobby of the police department.

Officers used the information provided by the reporting party which consisted of a first name, phone number, location of the sale and general description of the suspect. The officers were able to locate the suspect who was on felony probation with search and seizure conditions.

A probation search of a location in the 400 block of S. Prospect Ave. resulted in the recovery of multiple stolen high-end bicycles, and other items along with evidence of identity theft.

The suspect Brain Bond, age 46 of Redondo Beach was arrested. Redondo Beach Police Detectives worked with Manhattan Beach Police Detectives in efforts to solve thefts of bicycles that had occurred in both cities. The case was presented to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office and felony charges were brought against Brain Bond.
