Subject : L.A. Kings player Viatcheslav Voynov arrested for domestic violence.

This afternoon detectives from the Redondo Beach Police Department presented the current status of the Slava Voynov investigation to representatives from the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office. The assigned representatives reviewed the related police reports and evidence currently available for this case. Upon completion of the case review the District Attorney's office requested additional follow-up before making a determination on the filing of charges related to this investigation. Voynov is scheduled to appear in Torrance court on December 1, 2014. The investigation with the results of today's requests will be presented to the District Attorney's office prior to that date for continued consideration of filing charges.

Last night at approximately 11:25 p.m. Redondo Beach Police Officers responded to a call of a possible family fight at a residence in the area of the 800 block of Avenue C, located in the City of Redondo Beach. The call was received on a non-emergent business line with the caller reporting that a female could be heard screaming for the past twenty minutes and could now be heard crying. Officers responded to the area and after meeting with the citizen caller were able to determine which house the female was likely in. The officers were unable to contact the female or anyone else at the residence and received information that the female may have left in a vehicle prior to the officers arriving.

This morning at about 1:00 a.m., a call was received from the Torrance Police Department concerning an adult female being treated in the Little Company of Mary Hospital Emergency Room for injuries that were possibly received during a domestic violence incident that had occurred earlier in the City of Redondo Beach. Redondo Beach Police Officers responded to the hospital and met with the victim, determining that a domestic violence incident did occur in Redondo Beach. The officers conducted an investigation that resulted in the arrest of twenty four year old Viatcheslav Voynov, who was also present at the hospital. Voynov was arrested on a charge of 273.5(a) P.C. Voynov was booked at the Redondo Beach Police Department jail and held on \$50,000 bail. Voynov was released on bond at around 9:00 a.m. and is scheduled to appear in Torrance court on December 1, 2014.

The victim of this crime has requested confidentiality.
