

The Redondo Beach Police Department is seeking the public's help regarding the whereabouts of Emily Espinosa, a missing 16 year old Redondo Beach resident. Emily Espinosa is described as having short brown hair, brown eyes, weighs 112 pounds and is 5 feet 8 inches tall. Emily was last seen wearing denim shorts and a maroon top.

On July 22, 2015 (Wednesday) at approximately 8:00 am, Emily Espinosa, was seen walking away from the Mira Costa High School campus. Emily Espinosa was attending summer school at Mira Costa High School, where she was a junior. It is believed that Emily Espinosa was upset about a recent break up with a boyfriend and police had initial information that Emily Espinosa may have left with this boyfriend to Idaho, but this information has turned out to be false.

There is no indication at this time that Emily Espinosa was abducted or forced to leave Mira Costa against her own will. Family and friends have not heard from (including social media) or seen Emily Espinosa since she walked away on the morning of July 22, 2015. Emily Espinosa did not have a cell phone with her, or any bank cards/credit cards with her.
