

SUBJECT: MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT – FEBRUARY 2015

This report reflects the January Part I Crimes, and the Year To Date (YTD) totals. The **overall citywide crime statistics show a 26% increase** when comparing this year to last year. When comparing **February 2015 with February 2014 there was a 51% increase.**

There were 41 burglaries reported year to date: 73% were residential; 27% were commercial. Of the 217 larcenies reported year to date 39% were larceny from vehicle¹ (see *Other Statistics of Interest* table on page 3).
