SUBJECT: MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT – AUGUST 2015

This report reflects the July Part I Crimes, and the Year To Date (YTD) totals. The **overall citywide crime statistics show an additional 274 Part I crimes** (26% increase) when comparing this year to last year. When comparing **August 2015 with August 2014 there was an additional 44 Part I crimes** (12% increase).

There were 233 burglaries reported year to date: 79% were residential; 21% were commercial. Of the 865 larcenies reported year to date 36% were larceny from vehicle¹ (see *Other Statistics of Interest* table on page 3).
