Subject : Graffiti at Redondo Union High School

Redondo Beach Police Department were notified in the early morning hours on Friday, December 11, 2015, regarding graffiti within the school grounds at Redondo Union High School. The graffiti was a general threat of “YOU ARE ALL FUCKING ANIMALS BEING LED TO THE SLAUGHTER AS YOU DESERVE,” no specific threats were emailed or telephoned to Redondo Union High School. The graffiti was located on a sidewalk near the school cafeteria area spray painted in red.

There were earlier reports that Redondo Union High School had been placed on lockdown, which was not true. An increased police presence was initiated at Redondo Union High School because of the graffiti, but the school was never placed into “lockdown.” School District officials have been notified of the graffiti and parents of students have been made aware of the graffiti by Redondo Union School District officials.

At time of this press release, it is unknown if the separate incident occurring at Mira Costa High School in Manhattan Beach is related to the graffiti found at Redondo Union High School. Redondo Beach Police have contacted Manhattan Beach Police Department to ascertain if the two incidents are related.

Redondo Beach Police Department will investigate the graffiti crime that occurred at Redondo Union High School.
