

SUBJECT: MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT – OCTOBER 2015

This report reflects the October Part I Crimes, and the Year To Date (YTD) totals. The **overall citywide crime statistics show an additional 328 Part I crimes** (25% increase) when comparing this year to last year. When comparing **October 2015 with October 2014 there was an additional 31 Part I crimes** (23.5% increase).

There were 285 burglaries reported year to date: 79% were residential; 21% were commercial. Of the 1070 larcenies reported year to date 35% were larceny from vehicle¹ (see *Other Statistics of Interest* table on page 3).

Beginning in January 2015, the Rape category statistics are calculated using the new FBI/UCR and CA Department of Justice definitions. As of April 2015 this has resulted in one newly classified case. The 2014 statistics have not been adjusted.

As in all statistical comparisons, caution should be exercised in interpreting percent changes. When smaller numbers are compared the result is a greater percentage change; in other words, a more dramatic result is achieved.
