

SUBJECT: MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT – JANUARY 2016

This report reflects the January Part I Crimes, which is the Year To Date (YTD) totals. The **overall citywide crime statistics show 4 fewer Part I crimes** (2% decrease) when comparing this year to last year.

There were 34 burglaries reported this year: 82% were residential; 18% were commercial. Of the 111 larcenies reported this year, 33 were larceny from vehicle¹ (33%). See *Other Statistics of Interest* table on page 3 for more information.

Beginning in January 2015, the Rape category statistics are calculated using the new FBI/UCR and CA Department of Justice definitions. As of April 2015 this has resulted in one newly classified case. The 2014 statistics have not been adjusted.

As in all statistical comparisons, caution should be exercised in interpreting percent changes. When smaller numbers are compared the result is a greater percentage change; in other words, a more dramatic result is achieved.

BY COUNCIL DISTRICT

Council Districts 3, 4, and 5 have increased compared to last year. Council Districts 1 and 2 decreased, with Council District 2 having the largest decrease.
