SUBJECT: Monthly Statistical Report - APRIL 2016

This report reflects the April Part I Crimes, including the Year To Date (YTD) totals. The overall citywide crime statistics show 102 fewer Part I crimes (15% decrease) when comparing this year to last year. When comparing April 2016 to April 2015 there were 51 fewer Part I crimes (30% decrease).

NOTE: April's Part I Crime total of 118 is the lowest since April 2014, when we had 118 total Part I Crimes.

There were 123 burglaries reported this year: 72% were residential; 28% were commercial. Of the 341 larcenies reported this year, 111 were larceny from vehicle (33%). See Other Statistics of Interest table on page 3 for more information.

Beginning in January 2015, the Rape category statistics are calculated using the new FBI/UCR and CA Department of Justice definitions.

As in all statistical comparisons, caution should be exercised in interpreting percent changes. When smaller numbers are compared the result is a greater percentage change; in other words, a more dramatic result is achieved.
