



Recent Law Enforcement Events

9/5/16 – 1735 hrs.	1900 block of Farrell Ave.	On 09-05-16, at approximately 1735 hours, a neighbor in the 1900 block of Farrell Ave. observed a female transient enter a vehicle and remove U.S. currency and other property. The neighbor confronted the female and she fled. The neighbor reported her whereabouts to police who located her and placed her under arrest. The stolen property was recovered along with a canister of mace that she tried to spray at the neighbor.
9/6/16 – 0202 hrs.	Broadway Ave. at Topaz St.	On 09-06-16, at approximately 0202 hours, a male victim was walking in the area of Broadway Ave. / Topaz St. when a black passenger car drove up to him and three subjects exited. The suspects approached the victim and demanded he give them his property. When the victim declined one suspect threatened to shoot him, however, he did not produce a firearm. The victim ran away and the suspects fled in an unknown direction. The area was checked but the suspects were not located.
9/6/16 – 0837 Hours	200 Blk. Ave C	On 09-06-16, at approximately 0837 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 200 Blk of Ave C on a burglary report. The victim who is a federal law enforcement officer, parked and secured his vehicle in the alley overnight. In the morning the victim discovered the vehicle unlocked and ransacked. Property including ballistic vests, law enforcement jackets, and a gun safe (not containing a weapon) were taken. CSI responded to process the scene. On 09-09-16, information was developed through the investigation about the identity of a possible suspect. The suspect was located and detained and all of the stolen property was recovered and returned to the victim.
09/6/16 – 1126 Hours	2700 Block of 182 <sup>nd</sup> Pl.	On 09-06-16, at approximately 1126 hours, officers responded to a family disturbance call in the 2700 Blk. of 182 <sup>nd</sup> Pl. Upon arrival officers determined that a suspect had attempted to force entry into a home where his child and the child's mother reside. The victim refused to allow the suspect inside of the residence, resulting in the suspect breaking through a door in an attempt to gain entry. The suspect eventually fled the location without getting inside. As officers were taking the report information was developed on the possible whereabouts of the suspect. The DEU responded to a location in the city of Gardena, located and arrested the suspect without incident.

9-7/16/ 0304 hours	2123 Perry Ave. RB	On 09-07-16, at approximately 0304 hours, the victim observed an unknown male enter his vehicle in the 2100 Blk. Of Perry Ave., start it and then drive away. The victim followed the suspect into the City of Lawndale where the suspect fled on foot in the 16100 block of Firmona Ave. Due to the time delay of reporting the vehicle whereabouts, the responding police units were unable to locate the suspect. The stolen vehicle was returned to the owner. The suspect could only be described as a male, wearing an unknown color shorts.
9/10/16 2016	1519 Hawthorne Blvd	On 09-09-16, the victim and suspect have a fight in their vehicle in the 1500 Blk. of Hawthorne Bl. During the fight the suspect punches the victim in the face and pulls a knife on the victim and orders her to drive. At some point the suspect exits the vehicle and flees. The suspect takes the victim's purse when he flees the vehicle. Officers couldn't locate the suspect at this time. On 9-10-16, at approximately 2016 hours, the victim agrees to meet the suspect at 1519 Hawthorne Blvd to return the suspect's dog. During the meeting the suspect became upset. The victim got into her vehicle and tried to flee. The suspect climbed into the vehicle and began hitting the victim and started choking the victim. The suspect forced the victim out of the vehicle and the suspect fled in the victim's vehicle. The suspect was subsequently located and arrested by responding police officers.
9/112016 2125	1900 Bk. Nelson Av	On 09-11-16, at approximately 2125 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 1900 Blk. of Nelson Ave. to check the welfare of a subject after a relative received an email from the subject saying goodbye. Officers checked the residence and there was no answer at the door. Officers then check a rear detached garage where a light was on and found the victim inside, who had attempted suicide. Officers provided medical aid to the subject until paramedics arrived on scene and transported the victim to the hospital, where he is now in ICU.
