Upon a closer inspection by Officers it was determined to be suspicious in nature. Three Redondo Beach Police bomb detection K-9's responded to the general area as well. The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Dept. Bomb Squad responded and ultimately determined the briefcase did not contain anything dangerous.
