09-26-16 / 1556 Hours	Hawthorne Bl. / 182 <sup>nd</sup> St.	On Monday, September 26, 2016, at approximately 1556 hours, officers responded to the area of Hawthorne Bl. / 182 <sup>nd</sup> St. on a report of a traffic collision with injuries. A pedestrian that was crossing Hawthorne Bl. was struck by a bus that was travelling south on Hawthorne Bl. The pedestrian received significant injuries as a result of the Collision and was transported to an area trauma center in extremely critical condition. Traffic on Hawthorne Bl. was impacted as officers from the Traffic Unit responded to conduct the investigation. As of the following day was in ICU
09-27-16 / 1226 Hours	1900 Blk. Of Condon Ave.	On Tuesday, September 27, 2016, at approximately 1226 hours, communications received a call from a citizen who reported a subject climbing into a second story window of a residence in the 1900 Blk. of Condon Ave. The caller watched the window, providing updated information as officers responded to the area. Officers arrived on scene and a containment and command post were established. A search team was established and after announcements were completed the residence was searched and no suspects were located. It was determined that this residence was previously burglarized within the past two months. Since that crime the victim installed additional security measures which may have caused the suspect to flee shortly after entering the residence. The scene was processed and a crime report was completed.
9-27-16 / 1630 Hrs.	1800 Block of Armour Ln.	On Monday, 9-26-16 at approximately 2320 hours a neighbor heard a noise outside of the residence. When the neighbor looked outside, he observed a male subject inside of his neighbor's vehicle. The suspect fled on a skateboard.
9-26-16 / 2300 Hours	2000 Block of Harriman Ln.	The victim parked his vehicle on the street, however did not lock the vehicle. When the victim returned to his vehicle at approximately 0700 hours the next day, he noticed numerous tools missing from his vehicle.
9-28-16 / 1510 Hours	1900 Block of Spreckles Ln.	On Wednesday, 9-28-16 the victim reported that his house was burglarized between the hours of 0900 – 1200. He believed he left his front door unlocked and an unknown suspect(s) entered the residence and stole unknown items from the residence.
9-29-16/ 1854 Hours	1 Space Park Dr. Bldg E1	On Thursday, 9-29-16, at approximately 1854 hours the victim is approached by the suspect in the parking lot of 1 Space Park Dr. Building E1. The suspect asked the victim what was in a bag he was carrying. The suspect then pulled a handgun from his waistband and pointed it at the victim. The suspect demanded the victim's phone and wallet. The victim handed the suspect his phone. The victim the opened his wallet and showed the suspect the money. The suspect took the money from the wallet and then fled south through building E1 and R2. Suspect may have committed and earlier robbery in Manhattan Beach.
