PCH	On Monday, October 10, 2016, at approximately 0058 hours, patrol officers responded to a call of loud noises from inside the Global Pet Food Store in the 400 Blk. of PCH. One of the citizen callers yelled out that he was going to call the police and the noise stopped. Another witness observed a suspect exit the location, enter a vehicle and flee the area. Responding officers discovered the glass front double door was smashed and property removed from inside. In Culver City, there is another Global Pet Store which was burglarized during the same approximate time frame. The case is under investigation.
10-11-16 / 1640 Hrs.	1900 Blk Mathews Ave.	On Tuesday, October 11, 2016, at approximately 1640 hours, officers responded to a theft from a vehicle report. The victim parked his vehicle in front of his residence in the 1900 Blk. of Mathews Ave. on Oct. 9th and returned to his vehicle on Oct. 12 th and realized the catalytic converter had been cut off of his vehicle during that time frame.

Aviation Bl. / Goodman Ave.	On Friday, October 14, 2016, at approximately 2154 hours, two seventeen year old pedestrians were walking on the north side of Aviation Bl. at Goodman Ave. The victims walk past three suspects who are on the corner of Aviation and Goodman. The suspects approach the victims and point a silver semi-automatic handgun at the victims and demand their property, taking their cell phones and one of the victim's wallet. The suspects flee west on Aviation, while the victims run east to a nearby business and call police.

International Boardwalk and passed a subject walking on the upper bike path. After passing the pedestrian the citizen heard a loud thump. The citizen turned to look and no longer saw the pedestrian. The citizen looked down towards the International Boardwalk and observed the pedestrian had fallen from the upper bike path to the International Boardwalk. The Fire and Police Departments responded and located the pedestrian who sustained a head injury and was transported to an area hospital in critical condition. There was no evidence of foul play and it is unknown how the subject fell from the upper bike path.
