11-7-16 / 2219 hrs.	1800 Blk. S. PCH	On Monday, November 7, 2016, at approximately 2219 hrs., officers responded to a domestic violence incident in the 1800 Blk. of S. PCH where the victim and suspect were involved in a dating relationship. The male punched the female victim in the face and pushed her head against the steering wheel, while she was driving. The male exited the vehicle and fled. While officers were searching the area for him they heard screaming coming from the Arco Gas Station at PCH and Prospect Ave. The suspect in the domestic violence contacted a group of male subjects, after he fled from his girlfriend. They became involved in a physical altercation resulting in injuries to the suspect. The male suspect was treated and one other suspect was arrested from the second altercation. The incident was documented in crime reports.

Catalina Ave. and brandished a knife and demanded the victim's bicycle. The Victim was in fear for his life and surrendered the bicycle. The suspect was observed by responding officers and taken into custody. Officers located the stolen bicycle and the knife the suspect had used in the robbery. The suspect was booked at the Redondo Beach jail.

On Thursday, November 10, 2016, at approximately 2354 hrs., officers responded to Kovac's Pharmacy in the 2800 Blk. of Artesia Bl. for a burglary alarm, which was a glass break. An officer reviewed the video and saw the suspects who matched the description of the suspects involved in a recent crime form the City of Torrance. Shortly after Gardena PD went in pursuit, suspects possibly matching the description of our suspects. At the termination of the pursuit the suspects ran and one was arrested.
