



11-22-16 1515 hrs.	Torrance Bl. / PCH	On Tuesday, November 22, 2016, at approximately 1515 hours, based upon complaints from area residents, the Directed Enforcement Unit was conducting surveillance on a location in the southern portion of the city when a suspicious vehicle was observed leaving the location. Officers were requested to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle in order to conduct an investigation. The vehicle failed to yield and a short pursuit was initiated until the vehicle reached a dead end in the village apartment complex. Four suspects fled the vehicle on foot, two were captured almost immediately by the officers in the pursuing vehicle, and one was located in the Pier Plaza parking structure. Citizens on Catalina Ave. spotted the final suspect and alerted officers who were then able to locate and arrest that suspect after a foot pursuit through the complex. The vehicle is a reported stolen from the city of Murrieta and contained additional stolen property.
11-22-16 1951 hrs.	1516 S. PCH	On Tuesday, November 22, 2016, at approximately 1951 hours, officers were dispatched to Smart & Final at 1516 S. PCH regarding a theft. Two male suspects were in the store concealing bottles of alcohol in their jackets. As officers were responding, RBPD dispatch informed them that the suspects just exited the store with the alcohol and were getting into a gold Ford Expedition. One of the responding officers was able to locate the vehicle on S. PCH and conduct a traffic stop. A search of the vehicle revealed fifteen stolen bottles of alcohol. After a field show-up and positive identification, the suspects were placed under citizen's arrest. They were transported to RBPD jail and booked for commercial burglary.
11-24-16 2200 hrs.	PCH/Diamond ST	On Thursday, November 24, 2016, at approximately 2200 hours, a head on traffic collision occurred at the intersection of PCH/Diamond St. The driver of the vehicle that caused the collision fled the scene on foot. The suspect was located at Vincent St. /Juanita. The driver was arrested for DUI. During the investigation it was determined that the vehicle the suspect was driving was an unreported stolen vehicle out of the City of Torrance. The suspect was arrested and booked at RBPD on multiple charges.

11-25-16 1909 hrs.	700 Blk. N. Juanita	On Friday, November 25, 2016, at approximately 1909 hours, patrol officers were dispatched to a residence in the 700 Blk. of N. Juanita Ave on a report of an intoxicated subject causing a disturbance in the driveway. Officers arrived and walked down the driveway. They identified themselves and the suspect, who was seated on his motorcycle, accelerated towards the officers at 35 MPH. The officers had to jump out of the way to avoid being hit. The suspect came to within a foot of hitting the officers. The officers attempted to stop the suspect and a short pursuit ensued. The pursuit ended when the suspect collided with a motorist at 4 th St and PCH in the City of Hermosa Beach. The suspect was taken into custody without further incident. The suspect sustained moderate injuries as a result of the TC and was treated at a local hospital.
11-27-16 1535 hrs.	Beland Bl. / Inglewood Av.	On Sunday, November 27, 2016, at approximately 1535 hours, patrol officers were conducting a traffic stop on a vehicle in the area of Beland Bl. Inglewood Av. when they observed a hit run occur. One vehicle quickly fled the scene. Officers located the vehicle and a short vehicle pursuit ensued. The suspect vehicle came to a stop where the driver was contacted and arrested. A juvenile passenger was released to a relative. The suspect was evaluated for DUI and found to be over the legal limit. The suspect was arrested for charges related to the collision, pursuit, and DUI and booked at the Redondo Beach jail.
