One subject admitted to having an outstanding warrant. The other subject gave officer consent to search a backpack he was carrying. Search revealed a mail fishing tool with sticky pads used for fishing mail out of mailboxes. One of the sticky pads actually had a torn piece of envelope stuck to it. This subject was also in possession of cocaine. Both subjects were placed under arrest and transported to RBPD jail.

On Wednesday, November 30, 2016, at approximately 2204 hours, officers were dispatched to Kohl's department store regarding two male suspects that were in the process of stealing merchandise. The two suspects selected several items in the store and placed them inside of Kohl's shopping carts that they were each pushing. Suspects fled the business with the unpaid merchandise through the emergency exit doors located on the south side of the building. Both suspects entered an awaiting vehicle with the loaded shopping carts and fled the area. Officers located and stopped the vehicle on Artesia Blvd east of Hawthorne Blvd. Officers recovered over \$2500 dollars of stolen merchandise from the vehicle. Both suspects were arrested and booked for theft related charges.
