



The Redondo Beach City Council adopted its budget on June 15. It included funding changes that affected the Crossing Guard Program that is managed by the Police Department. In order to assist parents in preparing for the upcoming school year we are issuing this press release and posting the staffed crossing guard locations on our website. The City's website will also have recommended safe walking routes for children at each elementary school.

Traffic issues around the schools are always a concern. With the start of the school year we encourage all parents to prepare their children to walk to school safely and to follow the directions of the crossing guards. Additionally, at the request of the Redondo Beach Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Board and the Redondo Unified School District, we are also advising parents that the Police Department will be enforcing applicable traffic laws around the schools.

With strong partnerships between the City, the School District and parents we can continue to foster a safe environment for our children throughout the school year.
