The Redondo Beach PATH OF HISTORY




Part I, Original Town Site

HOTEL REDONDO
 A landmark of the 1930s, the great Spanish Mission Revival southern suburban was the Hotel Redondo. Located in what is now Veterans Park, the hotel had panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean and the beach. Redondo Beach's historic 225-room hotel found a home on every floor and a highlight in every season.
